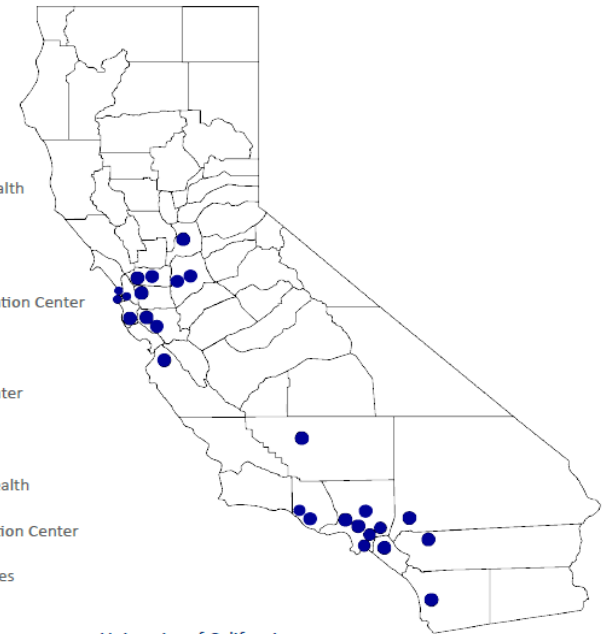
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Public Health Care Systems in California

- 21 systems spread across 15 counties
- County and UC health care systems
- Nearly 40% of hospital care provided to the uninsured
- About 25% of hospital care to Medi-Cal Managed Care enrollees
- Large primary and specialty care networks
- 2.85m+ unique patients, 10m+ OP visits annually
- 1/2 of Level I trauma centers, 2/3 of burn beds

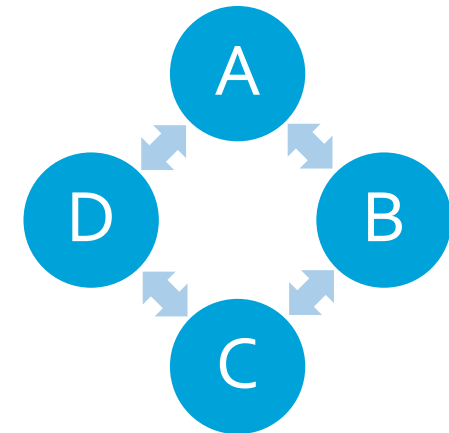
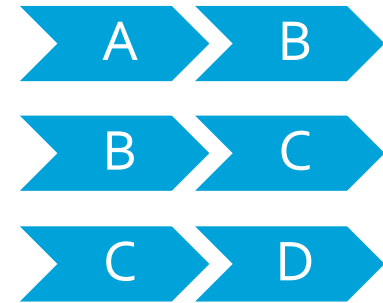
